## INTERNATIONAL MAIL OPTIONS

Creel Printing utilizes a foreign mail consolidator to process your foreign addresses. This allows us to get the best rates by combining your mail with others, heading to the same country. This consolidation does not slow your pieces down – we have 3 pickups a week (Mon, Wed, Fri).

We will provide all shipping info – pickup date – and release date to the foreign mail stream. Below find some of the options we provide and price for along with standard delivery expectations.

Creel will build a package of services best suited to each customer's unique requirements. When necessary we will even register your publication with the country of mailing to save you postage (See Canada Post options below).

## International Shipping

We have 3 types of international distribution: Mail (see pg. 8), Package Services through FedEx (see pg. 9), and Freight.

For Freight shipping into a foreign country (such as Canada) – Creel recommends that each client acquire their own Broker.

Creel will produce the Standard Commercial invoice and BOL. Customs will take the total value from the Commercial invoice and apply their duties and taxes – which must be paid before it can pass through the boarder. This is where your Broker comes in – they pay these fees and work out any boarder issues to expedite your product.

Creel has our own Broker (FTN – FedEx Trade Network) – but to utilize them we have extensive paperwork that needs to be filled out with each load, and duties and taxes must be paid upfront.
